Catholic Missions in Canada (CMIC)

This has been a voluntary fund of the Catholic Women's League since 2000. In the past 14 years members have donated \$345,000 towards the CMIC as it struggles to "keep the faith alive across our great country!" In 2015 CMIC hopes to provide \$3,500,000.00 in grants to assist 26 dioceses across Canada. There is a moving short film called "Great Need, Great Hope" which demonstrates the amazing work the CMIC is able to do, thanks to members' generosity.
