## Notice of Annual Meeting of Members

The 103<sup>rd</sup> Annual Meeting of Members of the Edmonton Diocesan Council of The Catholic Women's League of Canada will take place on Sunday, May 4<sup>th</sup>, 2024 at the Polish Hall Conference Centre at 10960-104 Street in Edmonton, Alberta, to promote the Objects of the League, to plan future programs, to present annual reports, and to conduct any other business of the Council.

### Information for Voting delegates – Accredited delegates – Members

Voting and Accredited Delegates from parish councils must complete a Credentials form.

Each CWL Parish Council is entitled to send **one Voting delegate** (President or designated representative) plus **two Accredited delegates** (executive or general members). It is strongly recommended that each Council send three delegates so that the Council and its members are adequately represented at the Annual Meeting of Members. If only one member from a Parish Council is attending, she should register as the Voting delegate as the President's designate. A Life Member should register as a Life Member rather than as a Council Accredited delegate, and an attempt should be made to have another member be the Council's Accredited delegate. Please register in only one category. Honorary Life Members and Life Members holding a membership in a council within the Archdiocese of Edmonton and the officers of the Edmonton Diocesan Council automatically have Accredited delegate status. Other meeting attendees are registered as Members and do not have voting privileges.

Voting delegates may vote on all Motions including any requiring an instructed vote (Note: no instructed votes will take place this year). Accredited delegates may vote on all Motions EXCEPT the election of officers, amendments to the *Constitution & Bylaws*, and an increase in per capita fees (C&B XV.2 (b)).
