As the month of September concluded with the Day for Truth and Reconciliation, and Orange Shirt Day - Let us learn, recognize and reflect on these events as we continue through the Fall.

October was the Month of the Holy Rosary. Through the Holy Rosary, we meditate on God's Word. The Gospel becomes embedded in our hearts, and Mary holds our hand to Jesus Christ. During the month of October we also pray for *The End to Abortion* by praying the Rosary during the "40 Days for Life".

November - This month the church celebrates All Saints & All Souls

This may be a great time for councils to plan Masses in remembrance of deceased members. An excellent resource to use would be #720 - Memorial Service for Deceased CWL Members (Available via the National CWL webpage (700 Series: Prayers and Hymns - The Catholic Women's League of Canada (cwl.ca)).

We also observe November 11th to recall the end of World War I on that date in 1918 and to honour the veterans of both World Wars.

<u>December</u> - The Advent season begins November 27 the first Sunday of Advent. It marks the start of the Christian year in western Christianity. Its length varies from 22 to 28 days ending on December 24.
