Reader 1: Globe

We present a Globe to remind us of our Creator God, who in your time this world was put in place, and in your time became beautiful, through the craftsmanship of your love. Remind us always as we look at sunrise, landscape or tiny child, to look beyond the artist brush or created thing, to the artist and Creator. Let us remember that your creativity calls us to share ours.

Reader 2: Water

Water is the source of all life. It is pure and refreshing. It flows, cleans, and nourishes. Water is a vital element we must take care of. Through the water cycle we are intimately connected to all of creation. As we present this vessel of water, let us remember how essential it is to all life on our planet. Let us strive to always care for it, use it wisely, and help keep it clean of pollutants.

Reader 3: Soil

We present this pot of soil to remind us of all the minerals and unseen resources it harbours within. Sometimes we forget that the earth we walk on is, like water, another source of life. From it, plants, trees, and all living creatures are nourished. We harvest its minerals and rocks to build our homes and cities. Let us remember to care for our earth and harvest its resources in moderation.

Reader 4: Seeds

As we present these seeds, we are reminded of the potential they possess. Seeds, if cared for lovingly and properly, grow, mature, and bear fruit. Like the seed, we too need to be loved, cared for and nurtured by all those around us in order to grow to our full potential as disciples of Christ. When we look at these seeds let us remember not only our potential, but that we need to love and care for others as well.

(Isaiah 42:5-6) As we present the image of a hand let us remember that God's hand is always outstretched into our lives and we are called to offer ours to our brothers, sisters and all of creation.

Reader 7: Cross

This cross reminds us of the profound love of God. Through His compassion, He gave us life and made our beautiful world. Let us remember to give thanks to Him always and praise Him for His wondrous creation.
